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| Course Title | Scottish Generic Instructor Training Bridging Course |
| Course Aim | The aim of this short session is to introduce, qualified clinical instructors to the Scottish Multiprofessional Maternity Development Programme; its organisation, management, quality assurance mechanisms, agreed teaching methods, courses and course content. |
| Course Learning Outcomes | By undertaking this session, participants will become familiar with the Scottish Multiprofessional Maternity Development Programme, its organisation, management and components. |
| Indicative content | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduction to the Scottish Multiprofessional Maternity Development Programme – quality assurance, relevant courses and course outline. • Four-stage teaching approach • Responsibilities of SMMDP Instructors |
| Teaching and Learning Strategies | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Self study • Lectures |
| Assessment Strategy | Assessment on 1 provider course as an Instructor Candidate |
| Nominal study hours | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taught Programme – 2-3 hours • Self study - 10 hours |
| Pre-requisites | Instructors who have instructor status for related courses, e.g. ALSO, NLS, or who have discipline specific clinical skills expertise – including teacher preparation courses – as agreed by the SMMDG, should undertake the Bridging course and one course as an Instructor Candidate. Once they have successfully completed their IC course, they are certified as full Instructors for the relevant programme. Their Instructor registration starts from the date of the successfully completed Scottish Multiprofessional Maternity Development Programme course. |

| Maximum number of candidates | 10 |
